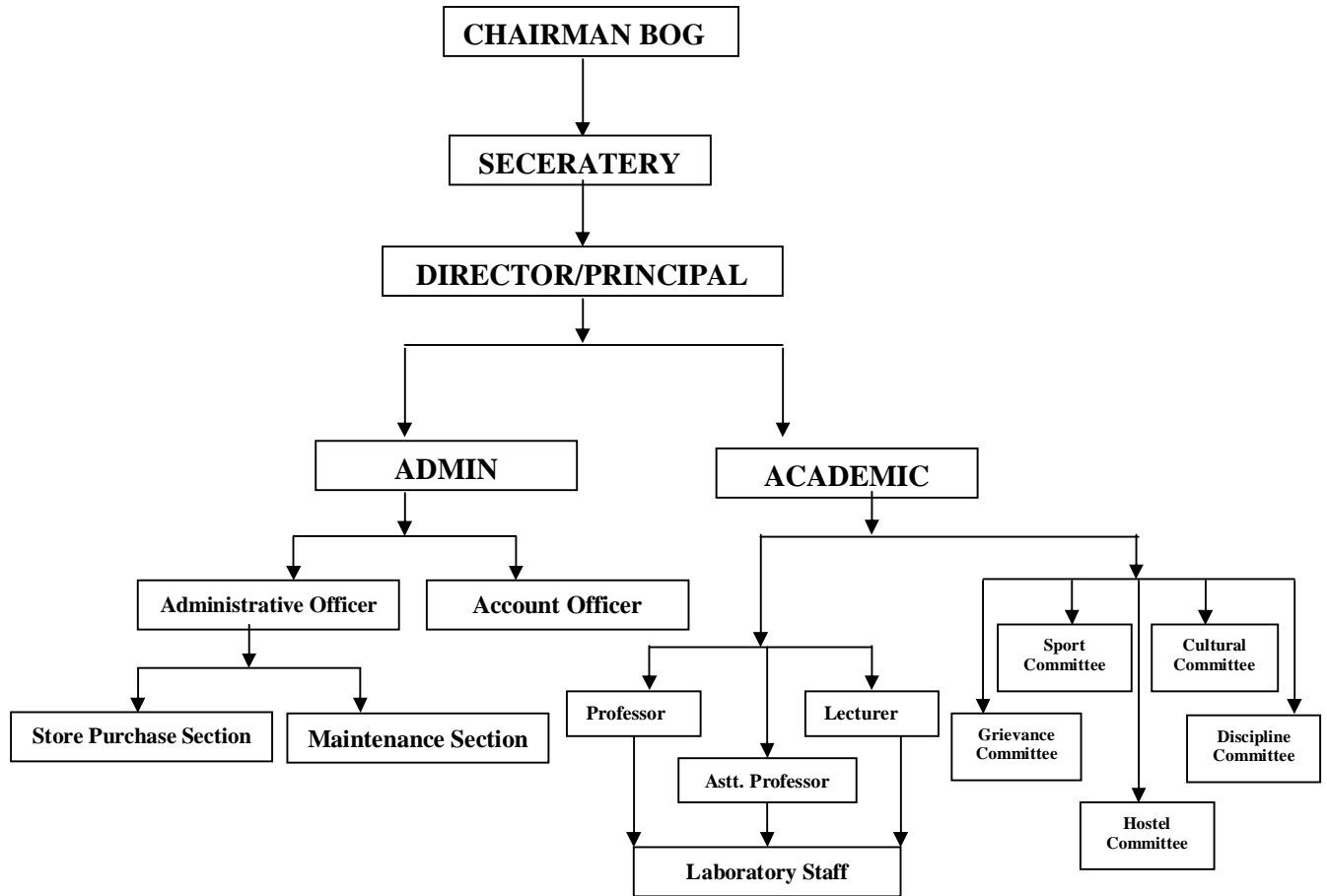

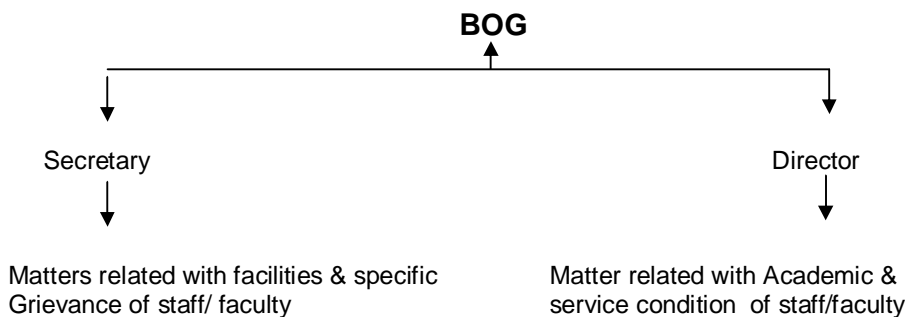

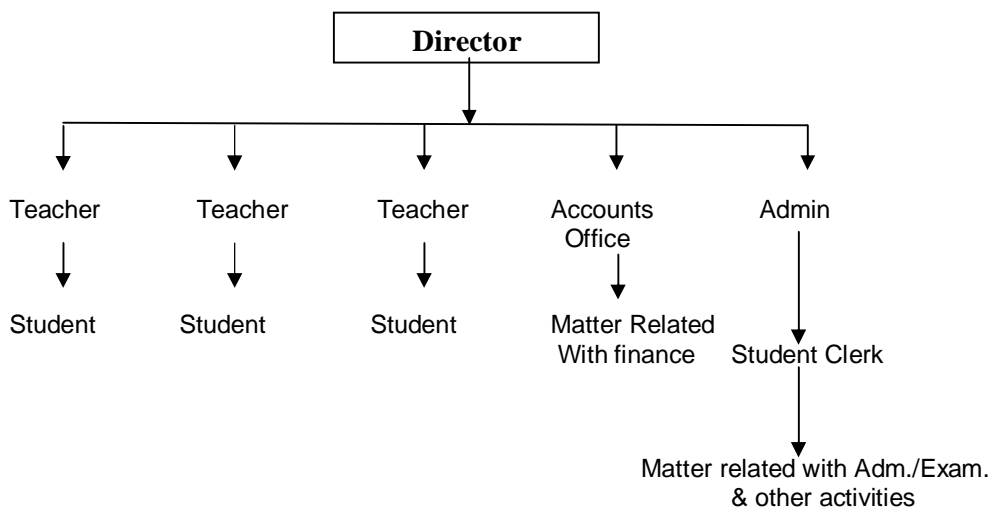

Research Interests: Novel drug delivery system/Application of dendrimers as drug delivery vehicle

Dendrimer, being well-defined and highly branched macromolecules, their multifunctionality and specific shape have been recognized as powerful tool in drug delivery. Polyamidoamine (PAMAM) dendrimers consist of central core, the radially standing intermediate repeating units, and the terminal functional group. It is known that amine terminated PAMAM dendrimers interact with negatively charged surfactants including phospholipids forming an envelope around the dendrimer molecules. PAMAM dendrimers act as solubility enhancers for acidic drugs through ionic interactions. The use of amine terminated PAMAM dendrimer for delivery bioactive agents through various routes such as oral and transdermal are under investigation.
